



Notification of Fee Increase

EFFECTIVE 30 MARCH 2026

Dear Patients,

Thank you for your continued support to our clinic. There will be a \$5 increase of our GP consultation fees effective 30 March 2026.

BULK BILLING CONTINUES FOR

Children under the age of 16, valid Commonwealth Concession Card holders and DVA Gold Card holders, on **weekdays before 5:00 pm** and **Saturday before 1:00 pm**.

There will be **no bulk billing** available after hours (from 5:00 pm on weekdays), from 1:00 pm on Saturdays (same fees as during the week up to 1:00 pm), or on public holidays (higher fees apply). All consultations will be charged privately. A reduced concessional fee will apply on Saturdays after 1:00 pm and on public holidays for eligible patients.

Our fees have been carefully considered and designed to be affordable while enabling us to meet the rising cost of delivering quality healthcare. For more details, please speak to our reception staff.

PLEASE NOTE

- Private fees will still apply for all procedures such as skin excisions, ear syringe, iron infusion, Implanon insertions, wound dressing, etc.
- Some services, such as certain eligible health assessments, chronic disease care plans and their reviews, will still be bulk billed for all.
- All visits for government subsidised vaccinations will continue to be bulk billed, provided no additional consultation takes place.
- Patients not eligible for the free flu shot will be charged a private flu fee, but no GP consultation fee unless they consult as well.
- These fees apply to both face to face and Telehealth appointments.



Private Vaccine & Iron Infusion Pricelist

EFFECTIVE 1 SEPTEMBER 2025

This pricelist applies to all vaccines not covered under the NIP (i.e. for travel or other purposes) that we currently stock at the clinic, including the seasonal private flu vaccine.

Tetanus booster, when indicated for injuries, will be provided free of charge using the Doctor's bag stock.

The vaccine fee is a private fee that does not attract any Medicare rebate and is in addition to any consultation fee or nurse procedure room fee where applicable. It is to be **paid prior** to the vaccine being administered.
